Cégep / college: Up to \$2,500 per student registered for full-time studies.

Category 3

I am a full-time secondary school vocational training student in a government recognized health and social services program;

I am studying at a government recognized educational institution located inside my home region;

I will commit to staying in a Quebec region following the completion of my studies to work for a minimum of one year in a public health and social services institution or related organization

Secondary school vocational training: Up to \$2,000 per student registered for full-time studies.
